1. Reference: PMARAI Legacy and Advocacy Project

2. BACKGROUND

A Lecture Series on Leadership and Excellence was conceptualized and adopted by the PMARAI Board as one of its legacy and advocacy projects. The Professional and Development Committee had been tasked as the Committee in charge of the project.

The Lecturers were selected based on their track record in the service, service reputation, competence, peculiar experiences, and and above all integrity. The initial list of lecturers are composed of the following:

1. Cav Benjamin Magalong '82
2. Cav Arturo Ortiz '79
3. Cav Ariel Querubin '79
4. Cav Ramon Liwag '79
5. Cav Ho Sun Yee '78
6. Cav Romeo Poquiz '81
7. Cav Jose Renan Suarez '82
8. Cav Danilo Pamonag '85

The cadets of the Philippine Military Academy were selected as the first recipients of the lecture. The succeeding lectures will be conducted in the AFP Officers School, then Philippine National Police Academy, Maritime Academy of the Philippines, ROTC students of the different government and private civilian universities. Lectures will be done in the venues bimonthly or once every two months.

3. SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

a. Pre-Event Coordination

The Committee began a series of coordination with Key Officers of HPMA as early as 6 September 2023. LTC MARK ANTHONY B RUELOS PA, then MA7, was the initial Contact Person of CAVALIER JOB NOLAN ANTONIO '82. LTC RUELOS

asked for a formal letter for the lecture series for the approval of the SUPERINTENDENT, PMA. Said letter (Annex A) was endorsed to MA8. On 7 October 2023, CAV ANTONIO coordinated with LTC VINCENT DAVID S BONIFACIO PA, then MA8, for important updates. CAV ANTONIO was informed that the request was already endorsed to the Tactics Group for final scheduling in November 2023. On 17 October 2023, LTC GEOFFREY A FABROS PA, Asst MA3, called CAV ANTONIO for the final date of the lecture series. Initial coordination was also made with the PMA Housing Authority for billeting purposes at Nakar Hall, PMA.

On 07 November 2023, CAV ANTONIO followed up with LTC BONIFACIO for the latest update on venue and audience of the lecture series. During the coordination, CAV ANTONIO was informed that there has been some rotation of Key Officers of HPMA. The new MA3 is LTC REX C BOLO PA and the Acting MA7 is LTC FABROS PA, while LTC BONIFACIO was already relieved from PMA for schooling. Because of this rotation, LTC BOLO became the final Contact Person of the Committee. On 14 November 2023, the Program (Annex B) for the 1st Lecture Series was provided to MA3 with COMMO ROGER P VIDUYA PN as Representative of the Superintendent to deliver the Welcome Remarks. Meanwhile, the Budget Requirement was presented to the Board last 13 November 2023 for approval (Annex C).

CAVALIERS RAMON LIWAG '79, ROMEO POQUIZ '81, and JOB NOLAN ANTONIO '82 with two drivers left Metro Manila o/a 0600H 17 November 2023 on board two vehicles and arrived safely at Baguio City o/a 1120H same date. CAVALIERS LIWAG, POQUIZ, ANTONIO and the drivers checked-in at Nakar Hall o/a 1411H 17 November 2023. At this point, there was a slight change in the Program with the Superintendent himself delivering the Welcome Remarks. Immediately, CAV ANTONIO went to the MA3 Office to correct the Program. LTC BERNARD RODERICK A JOAQUIN PAF, Asst MA3, assisted CAV ANTONIO and successfully changed the Program (Annex D). At this point, CAV ANTONIO and LTC JOAQUIN made an ocular inspection of the Lopez Hall of Leaders which was the venue of the lecture series. CAVALIER DANILO G PAMONAG '85, one of the Speakers, and party arrived at Nakar Hall o/a 1930H 17 November 2023 with no untoward incident.

b. Event Summary

On or about 0730H 18 November 2023, CAVALIER RICARDO F DE LEON '71, Director General, NICA, and party arrived at Nakar Hall. At this instance, CAV LIWAG mentioned to CAV DE LEON the purpose of our visit to PMA. CAV DE LEON then informed us that he was invited to give a talk on Servant Leadership which was very timely because his talk preceded the 1st PMARAI Lecture Series: Leadership and Excellence in the Service and Beyond. Both groups left Nakar Hall minutes apart and proceeded to the Lopez Hall of Leaders. (Pictures – Annex E) CAVALIER JOSE RENAN SUAREZ '82 joined the group o/a 0900H 18 November 2023.

The 1st PMARAI Lecture Series started on time. The emcee for the Opening Ceremonies was 2LT RIANEL R GARZOTA NC. The Welcome Remarks was delivered by LTGEN ROWEN S TOLENTINO PA, followed by the Opening Remarks of CAV ROMEO POQUIZ, Chairman of the PMARAI Professional Development Committee. After the Opening Ceremonies, a short technical break was given to the cadets for the speakers to prepare their presentations. After the break, the lecture series began in earnest and moderated competently by CAV JOB NOLAN ANTONIO, who also made brief but concise introductions per speaker (Annex F). In attendance during the entire lecture series was BGEN RAMON P FLORES PA, Commandant of Cadets.

The first speaker was CAV DANILO PAMONAG, and his talk was about "Leadership in the Battlefield" (Annex G – Manuscript). He talked about his actual lessons learned and other experiences as the leader during the Zamboanga siege in 2013 and during the Marawi Siege, both of which required urban warfare. This was followed by the talk of CAV RAMON LIWAG on "Good Leaders: Hope of the Filipino Nation" (Annex H – Manuscript). He begun his talk by playing a video clip on his musical composition "Buhay Sundalo." This was followed by actual disaster response operations and management scenarios as well as other national building projects, which he himself led as te Coast Guard Commandant. Lunch break followed, with the PMARAI group joining the Cadet Corps, AFP at Yap Hall.

After the lunch, the third talk by CAV JOSE RENAN SUAREZ started the afternoon with his topic on "Achieving Financial Security" (Annex I – PowerPoint Presentation). CAV SUAREZ gave pointers on practical personal financial management to the cadets, which were not only timely but also very relevant.

CAV POQUIZ delivered the fourth and final talk entitled: "Real Story – Leadership Excellence in Combat and Non-combat Situations". He made a detailed narrative on how he was able to transform the then very inefficient and disorderly Air Force Finace Center into a fully automated and modern system, within three months, without asking for additional funds from higher headquarters. He was able to set up a system where claims which used to be received after six months was given, without any need for follow-ups, within 24 to 48 hours. Also, as the commander of the then newly created PAF Combat Group, he provided critical and effective management and leadership to the unit engaged in ground counter-insurgency operations, which is a non-core function of the PAF. He transformed the Group, a shabby unit composed of PAF misfits and often the laughingstock of the Army, into the fightingest and the best combat battalion in the entire Southern Luzon Command area composed of the Southern Tagalog amd Bicol regions. The Group bested many army infantry and special forces battalions in th Southern Luzon Command area.

CAV ANTONIO summarized each talk by presenting the takeaways to reinforce the learning process. The summary was very helpful in making the cadets absorb the major points of each topic. A detailed report will be submitted for the purpose. Immediately after the final talk, an Open Forum followed which was moderated by CAV ANTONIO. The Open Forum generated numerous questions

from both the First Class and Fourth Class Cadets, even BGEN FLORES sought the speakers their unsolicited advices what made PMA Classes 79 to 85 produced outstanding leaders. The lecture series was well moderated and finished as scheduled with appropriate Closing Ceremonies again emceed by 2LT GARZOTA. A Letter of Thanks (Annex J) was presented by CAV LIWAG, most senior director of PMARAI, to BGEN FLORES for the Superintendent, PMA.

The lecture series was attended by more or less 650 cadets and a big number of Officers from HPMA and the Tactics Group. Despite the daylong seminar, the cadets were very attentive throughout the lectures. Even the Fourthcalss cadets hardly dozed off. A video recording of the whole proceedings will be submitted by HPMA to the PMARAI in December 2023.

The lecture served its purpose of enhancing the education and training of the cadets, not only on the actual field experiences and accomplishments of the lectures, but also on how these were done expertly, consistently and with integrity. Gen FLORES, the Commandant, thanked the PMARAI and the lecturers for their passion to share their experiences but also for their competence and track record. The Senior Tactical Officer, LtCol Ryan Samonte, commented that the PMARAI advocacy was very good, the perspective is different from other lectures, and that the speakers, mostly PMA Cavalier and TOPS Awardees are very credible.

4. Request that this report be made part of the Lessons Learned to further improve the services of the PMARAI.

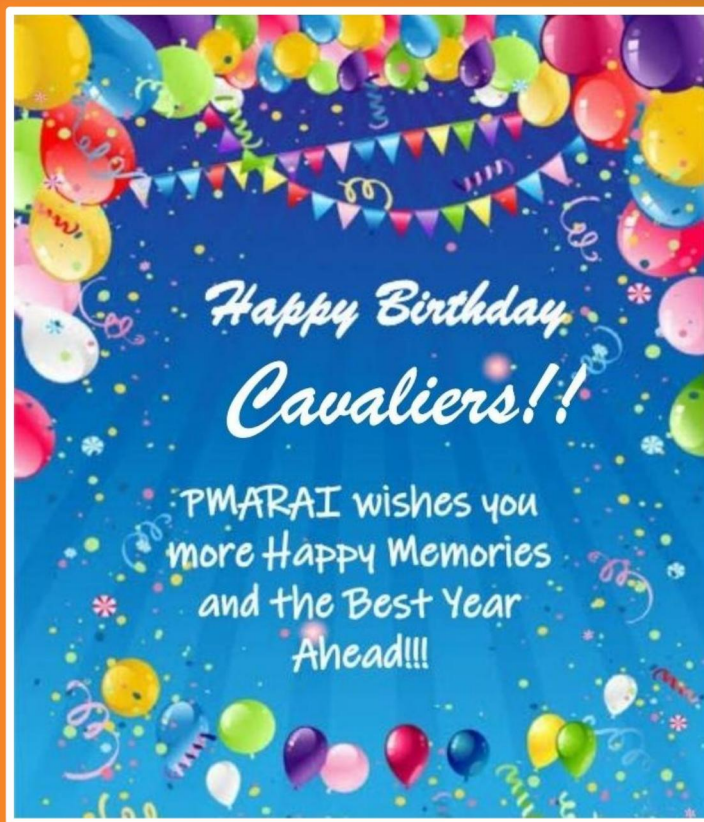
