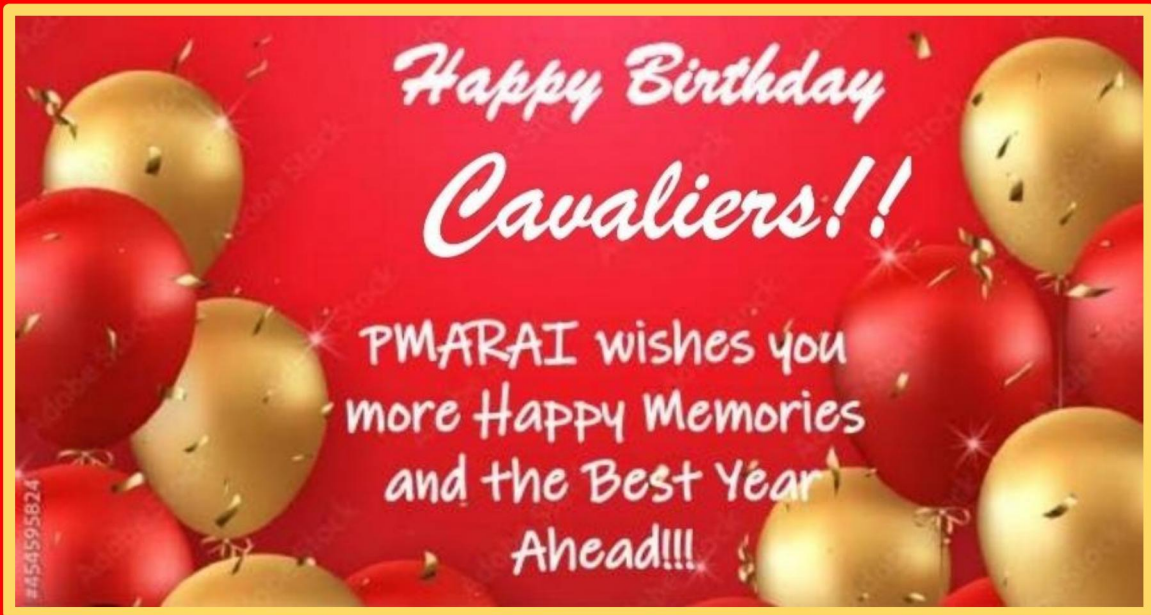
While societal norms, like the prohibition of alcohol, smoking bans, and women's

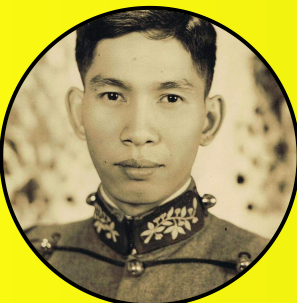

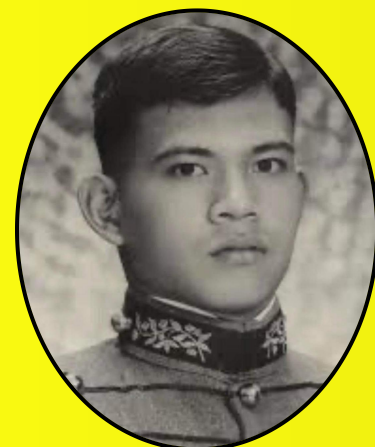
