For the 2023 GOC, the tournament will be held in the three military golf courses in Metro Manila.

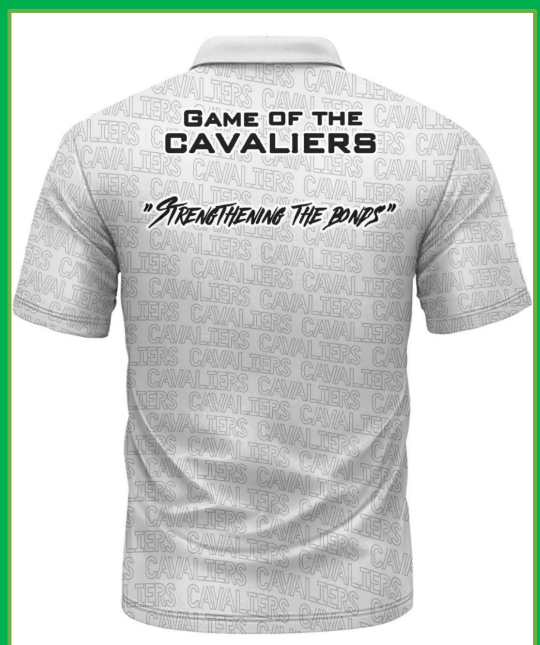
