



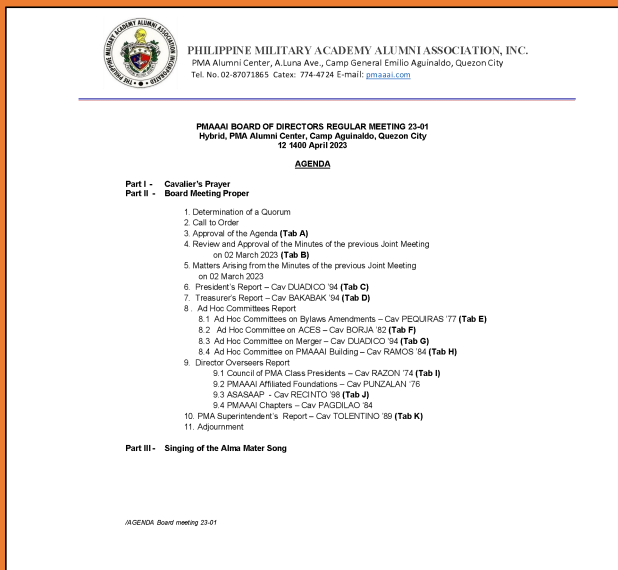

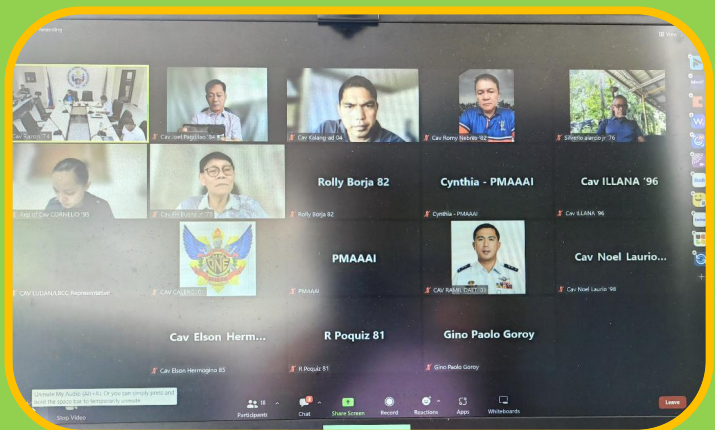

AVIATION COOPERATIVE FOR ENHANCED SERVICES (ACES)

➤ **Multipurpose cooperative** duly registered with the Cooperative Development Authority

Objectives, purposes and powers of ACES, among others:

1. To engage in Air Transport of Passenger and Cargoes, and other aviation related services;
2. To encourage thrift and saving mobilization among members for capital formation;
3. To accept **share capital** and **deposit** from members and **grant loans** to them for productive and providential purposes;

FACTS ABOUT ACES

- The financial problems of ACES surfaced sometimes in late 2015 or early 2016 – no more withdrawal allowed
- Acting on a Complaint, CDA issued on August 3, 2016 a Cease and Desist Order(CDO) directing ACES to cease and desist from undertaking its business activities;
- In January 2018, ACES filed with the CDA a proposed Rehabilitation Plan but same was returned inasmuch that per evaluation, the plan is not feasible;
- A Revised Rehabilitation Plan was submitted which was approved by CDA on March 11, 2020 .
- With the approval of the Rehabilitation Plan, the CDO was lifted and ACES could now continue its business operations.

ACTIONS TAKEN ON THE ACES ACCOUNT

- As early as August 2016, a Team was organized to transact and negotiate with ACES for the full recovery of the deposits/placements together with the uncollected interest.
- Written demands for the withdrawal of the deposits were sent to ACES
- Meetings were held with the President of ACES.
- Explore the possibility of entering into a dacion pago for the settlement of ACES' obligations to PMAAAI.
 - *Dacion en pago*- payment in kind of a monetary obligation.
 - ACES offered to dacion a **condominium unit located in Paranaque city** and a **parcel of land located in Tanay**;
 - ACES failed to provide a copy of the title for the Tanay property.
 - The appraised value of condominium unit is P7.5M.
 - PMAAAI sent a letter accepting the dacion of the condominium unit as partial payment but PMAAAI did not receive any response from ACES.

ACTIONS TAKEN ON THE ACES ACCOUNT

- ☐ In 2019, PMAAI secured the services of an accountant to determine facts on the ACES investment; review the investment transaction; review and assess existing investment policies; and craft a suitable investment portfolio mix and investment policy.
- ☐ Requested the CIDG to conduct investigation to determine possible criminal liabilities of those involved in the transactions.
- ☐ Secured the services of an external counsel and a Criminal Complaint was filed against the former Board members and officers of PMAAI and ACES for:
 1. Violation of Lending Company Regulation Act of 2007
 2. Falsification of Documents
 3. Syndicated Estafa.
 - ❖ City Prosecutor of Quezon City **Dismissed** the Complaint.

ACTIONS TAKEN ON THE ACES ACCOUNT

❑ Criminal Complaint against ACES

1. Violation of Lending Company Regulation Act of 2007 - Engaging in the business of lending/granting loans to members without authority from the SEC;

Resolution – 1. Cooperatives are excluded from the definition of lending company; hence, not covered by said law; and 2. granting of loans to its members is one of the powers of ACES.

2. Falsification of Documents- conspiracy to commit falsification of documents by preparing and approving simulated audited financial statements from 2005-2015 by making it appear that ACES has consistent and unprecedented growth.

Resolution – no evidence was introduced to prove the falsity of the audited financial statements other than the self-serving analysis.

ACTIONS TAKEN ON THE ACES ACCOUNT

❑ Criminal Complaint against ACES

1. Syndicated Estafa - a) BOD of ACES misappropriated the investment of PMAAI through irregular, grossly disadvantageous, questionable loans, b) grave abuse of discretions and conflict of interest tantamount to fraud committed by certain Directors of PMAAAI and ACES, c) misused or abused of ACES funds.

Resolution -

a) ACES is not a syndicate within the definition of PD No. 1689;

b) PMAAAI is not a member of ACES, by its nature, the money placements of PMAAAI are in the nature investments in the form of loan; hence, PMAAAI is a creditor of ACES;

c) failure to identify the participation of respondents in the money receive as placements; PMAAAI made money placements with ACES which was duly acknowledged by the latter; there was no instance where the respondents have been in juridical possession of the said money.

d) no duty on the part of ACES or any of respondents of trust, or on commission, or for administration, or to make a delivery, to return the same; money placements are the form of loans.

PMAEE Schedule 2023

The PMA Office of Cadet Recruitment and Admission has announced the opening of the PMA Cadet Online Application System for the 2023 PMAEE. The application portal is available from May 1 to August 1, 2023 only. Since last year, the PMA no longer accepts walk-in and mail applications so the only way to apply is through the portal. If you are having difficulty applying online, you can always try to do it during off-peak hours, when traffic to the website is low.

Here are the qualifications and requirements to become a cadet in the PMA:

- Natural Born Filipino Citizen.
- Physically fit and of good moral character.
- Single and has never been married nor pregnant nor has a legal obligation to support a child or children.
- Must pass the PMA Entrance Examination.
- No Administrative / Criminal Case.
- At least High School Graduate with at least **85% GPA**
- The height requirement for both males and females is 5 feet (not to exceed 6'4" for both).
- At least 17 years old but not a day older than 22 years on **June 1, 2024**.
